It is just as Isaiah said previously: "Unless the Lord Almighty had left us descendants, we NIV would have become like Sodom, we would have been like Gomorrah." And Isaiah said the same thing in another place: "If the LORD of Heaven's Armies had not spared a few of our children, we would have been wiped out like Sodom, destroyed like NLT Gomorrah." And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as KIV Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.
