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|     | <div>הִיָּה</div> <div>הִיָּה</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</div> <div>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</div> <div>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 <span>וְשָׁתִי כְלִתִּיהָ עִמָּה</span></div> <div>Hebrew</div> <div><div>אֶרֶץ</div><div>אֶרֶץ</div><div>hebrew</div><div>Meaning:</div><div>* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country</div><div>The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.</div><div>When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 <span>יְהוּדָה</span></div></div> |

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|  | <p><b>καί</b>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</p> <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” <b>ἐξῆλθεν ἐκ τοῦ</b>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article <b>τόπου οὗ ἦν</b>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.</p> <p>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 <b>λουᾶ</b></p> |
