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|     | <div>הִיְהִי<span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>הִיְהִי</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>The word הִיְהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</div> <div>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</div> <div>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בְּכֹל הָאָרֶץ<span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>אָרֶץ</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country</div> <div>Hebrew</div> <div>The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.</div> <div>When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 הָאֲדָמָה<span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>הָאֲדָמָה</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* Yahweh - God's personal name</div> <div>It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.</div> <div>First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 פִּי שָׁנִים בָּהּ יִכְרְתוּ יִגְעוּ וְהַשְׁלֵשִׁית יִנְתָּר בָּהּ</div> |

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| LXX | <div>καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί</div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</div> <div>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” <span>ἔσταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div> <div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. <span>ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning “in”. <span>πάσῃplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* All * Every * The whole</div> <div>Adjective.</div> <div>Usage in the New Testament</div> <div>The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.</div> <div>With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 <span>τῇplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article <span>ἡplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἡ</span></div> <div>Meaning:</div> <div>* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)</div> <div>Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.</div> <div>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 <span>λέγει κύριος τὰplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article <span>δύο μέρη</span> ἐξολεθρευθήσεται <span>καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</div> <div>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” <span>ἐκλείπει τὸplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>The definite article <span>δέplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. <span>τρίτον ὑπολειφθήσεται ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>Preposition meaning “in”. <span>αὐτῇplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός</span></div> <div>greek</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same</div> <div>Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.</div> <div>Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)</div> |
