Hebrew	The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ.Genesis 1:1 יְרוּשָׁלַם לְרֵאוֹת כַּמָּה רְחֹבָה וְכַמָּה אֲרָצָה
ESV	Up! Up! Flee from the land of the north, declares the LORD. For I have spread you abroad as the four winds of the heavens, declares the LORD.
NIV	“Come! Come! Flee from the land of the north,” declares the LORD, “for I have scattered you to the four winds of heaven,” declares the LORD.
NLT	The LORD says, “Come away! Flee from Babylon in the land of the north, for I have scattered you to the four winds.

Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 συναῶμα ὑμᾶς λέγει κύριος
