Hebrew	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things.
