Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קרב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 לא יעשה עולה בבקר בבקר משפטו יתן לאור לא נעדר ולא ידע עול בשת
ESV	The LORD within her is righteous; he does no injustice; every morning he shows forth his justice; each dawn he does not fail; but the unjust knows no shame.
